

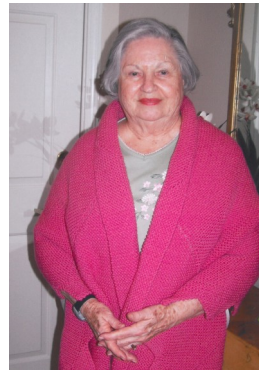


Warmed by Prayer

"I'm Going On"

Georgene Johnson who lives in Cleveland, Ohio, had just turned 42 years old and made a decision to make the very best out of her life. She committed to looking good, feeling good, and conditioning herself well. She decided to start running and training hard. One day, she had the bright idea to enter a 10K event.

The day arrived for the first race and she arrived early. She noticed hundreds of people, stretching and milling about. Then a voice came over the speaker, "All runners prepare for the race start."

Georgene took her place and started out on the six-mile race. About four miles into the event, she noticed the runners were not turning



back toward the start-finish line. She asked an official why the racers were not turning around and was told, "Lady, you are in the Cleveland Marathon." The Cleveland Marathon was twenty-six miles. Her race was to have started thirty minutes later.

Most of us would have dropped out at that point. Not Georgene! She said to herself, "I'm going on," and she did, finished the entire twenty-six miles. Later, she said,

"This is not the race I trained for. This is not the race I entered. But for better or worse, this is the race that I am in..." (Mark Trotter)

How many times have you found yourself in a race you did not train for? How many times have you found yourself in a race you did not enter? What do you do? Drop out? Give up? Or go on?

The Apostle Paul says, "...let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us." (Hebrews 12:1)

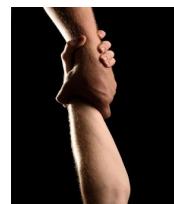

From the Disco Ball...

Who would have thought it –a disco ball in the middle of worship center!! We have one at Genesis, but we call it a “Grace Ball.” II Corinthians 12: 9 says, “And He has said to me, ‘My grace is sufficient for you, for power is perfected in weakness.’ Most gladly, therefore, I will rather boast about my weakness, so that the power of Christ may dwell in me” (NASB). In the beginning of the chapter Paul talks about the “thorn in the flesh” in which he says keeps him from exalting himself. As Paul acknowledged his weakness, Christ was reflected in all areas of Paul’s ministry. For us here at Genesis, each small piece of mirror (a few hundred at least) represents the endless covering of God’s grace. It reminds us that our ministries here are not perfected by us, but by the power of Christ in us! As the ball turns and the light shines we not only see, but feel God’s amazing love! If you know someone who feels they are hopeless, ask them to come (or bring them) to Genesis—a place to get some Jesus love, and where they can discover that God’s love is available for everyone—even them.

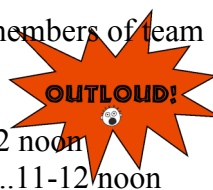

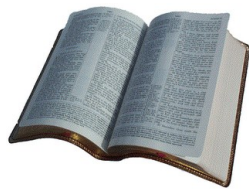

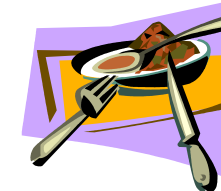
